#### The Races

1. Races will be started by using the 5 minute sound system.
2. All Classes will start together.
3. Boats infringing a rule on the water may be exonerated by completing a one turn penalty.
4. It is expected that a disagreement on the water will result in a Corinthian discussion by competitors on shore after racing.
5. No protest will be heard.
